## What you can do to help your child succeed this year:

- Help your child prioritize school. Your child is responsible for completing work in every class, every day. .
- Encourage your student to stay positive and seek help from teachers, counselors, and administrators
- The parent does not have to be the expert in the subject; Encourage your student to self advocate and reach out to the teacher for help. This process is the same as raising their hand in class.
- Be sure you can log in and access your child's PowerSchool grades. Call the office if you need help accessing PowerSchool.
- Email your child's teacher(s) if you have questions and/or to introduce yourself.
- Answer all calls from the school or listen to voice messages; ECHS posts transcripts of each call
  on the school homepage.
- Contact the school to update your phone and email information if you are not receiving the messages.

## Tips/Tricks for your student's success:

- School should be your student's priority.
- Setting a routine for your student will help ensure success. Ideally between the hours of 8:00-3:15. Teachers are available during this time. After 3:15, it might be the next day before a teacher responds.
- Time management is key to balancing school, work, and home.
- Keep a physical agenda of assignments and due dates.
- Use timers to help your student organize the day and complete work on time.
- It's important for your student to read all the directions and watch all the videos provided by teachers.
- Be patient. Be patient with your student(s), their teachers, and yourself.
- Remind them to sign in each teacher's classroom and fill out the daily attendance form each teacher.
