Grading and Student work:

- GRADES MATTER THIS SEMESTER
- You can expect at 60 minutes of online work whether you are 100% virtual or in a cohort
- Assignments given on Monday and Tuesday are due on Wednesday of that week.
- Assignments given on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday are due that Friday.
- The assignments are due the week they are assigned. Make sure to understand when the assignments are due. If you submit an assignment late it will receive a zero. Make sure you keep up with your assignments and their due dates!!

- Cheating of any sort <u>WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!</u> Any cheating will result in a zero for all parties involved and disciplinary action will be taken.
- Grades will come from tests, quizzes, homework, and participation.
- Students may complete test corrections on any Test. You will have 3 days to complete the corrections.
- Homework will be given on most days. It will be checked regularly for effort and completion. Effort is very important in learning mathematical subjects.
- Students will be required to do assignments through the IXL website that reinforces the lessons and provides practice for the mathematical subjects.
- A 3 ring binder will be required for notes, handouts, assignments and homework. Notebooks will be checked. (All virtual students should keep notes for future reference)

Calculators:

Calculators will be provided for in-class use only. Desmos and various other online graphing calculators will suffice for online assignments.
